Dear Parents/Carers,

URGENT MESSAGE: It has come to my attention that there are real e-safety issues surrounding a new app known as Musical.ly. Twice this app has been brought to my attention; some have used it to write unkind messages about others on it but more seriously, I have been informed of an attempt to groom an ex pupil of the school via the app. The perpetrator has used the message facility to send messages to the victim who switched off the privacy settings; it was only when the child informed their parent of the messages that it came to light. I can not highlight more seriously the importance of checking what your child is using online and whether they have set the privacy settings on apps they are using so that they are not contacted by those with inappropriate intentions. Even if they tell you that they have set their privacy setting, they may still make their profiles public—this is the real danger here. **PLEASE CHECK WHAT YOUR CHILD IS USING THE INTERNET FOR.**

A big thank you to all those parents and carers who took the time to come to the information session to find out about what their child will be learning about this year. This shows that you really take your child's education seriously and want to work alongside the school; it would be great to see even more next year,

This week saw the first 'Growth Mindset' assembly. Children recapped over Craylearning thinking about what an effective learner does. Thank you to all those children who completed Lenny's Craylearner task—these are now on display in the main entrance.

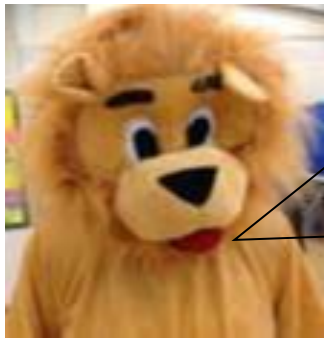
-- Do your best to ensure your child attends schools as much as possible. 95% is good attendance; anyone below 90% will be contacted.
