Dear Parents/Carers,

Where did that term go to? It seems to have flown by! We are now two thirds of the way through the year.

A big thank you to those of you who attended the ROAR assemblies this week to celebrate your child's good behaviour. It is a shame that more parents/carers from Years 5 and 6 do not attend, as their behaviour should particularly be recognised, as children can often struggle to keep to the rules as they move up through the school. We have now started recording warning and consequence cards for the next ROAR assemblies so if anyone has been issued with a card since the assemblies, they will count towards the end of term 6; this ensures that we maintain high expectations of behaviour at all times of the year, as some children often think that they can misbehave after receiving their award.

Can I remind you all of how important attendance is to your child's education. When they miss a day from school, this can impact on their understanding when they return as they may have missed the build up to the work that they are completing when they are back. We do have concerns that there have been some sightings of children who are meant to be ill, out on the streets during the school day—if we feel that any parent is keeping their child off school when they are not sick, we will have to consider reporting to the Education Welfare Officer.

For Year 6, it is vital that between Easter and 12th May, the children are in school as much as possible so that they can be as prepared for the SATs tests as possible. Year 2 also need to be in as much as possible, particularly towards the end of May, when their SATs tests will be carried out.

Over the Easter holidays, there may be some development in the construction of the new toilet block for the end EYFS classroom. Whilst I cannot guarantee that this will be the case, it may be that the children will not be able to access around the back end of the school, if contractors have mobilised over the break.

This week, we had a number of sporting successes. The boys football team won by a massive 10-0 against Bean this week and the netball team won 10-6. Well done to both teams and all children who played. A number of girls from Y5 + Y6 have attended a Futsal tournament at Ebbsfleet this morning—I am sure that they have had fun!

A big thank you to the Friends of Craylands for a great neon disco last week - thanks to all parents and staff who supported.

Today, Miss Meechan returned to school—we are glad to see her back. We thank Miss Marlton for all she has done in covering Elmer class.

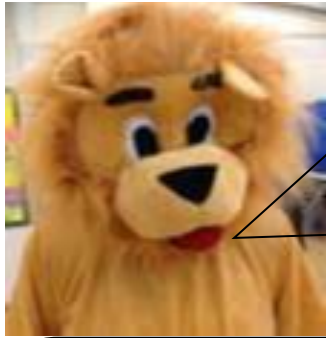
Reminders!
