- Children should only wear small, flat studs as earrings; some of the children are wearing earrings that, if caught during playtimes, could really hurt them.

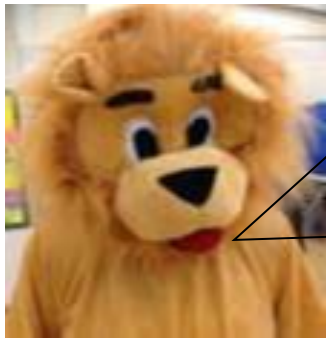
## A big thank you!

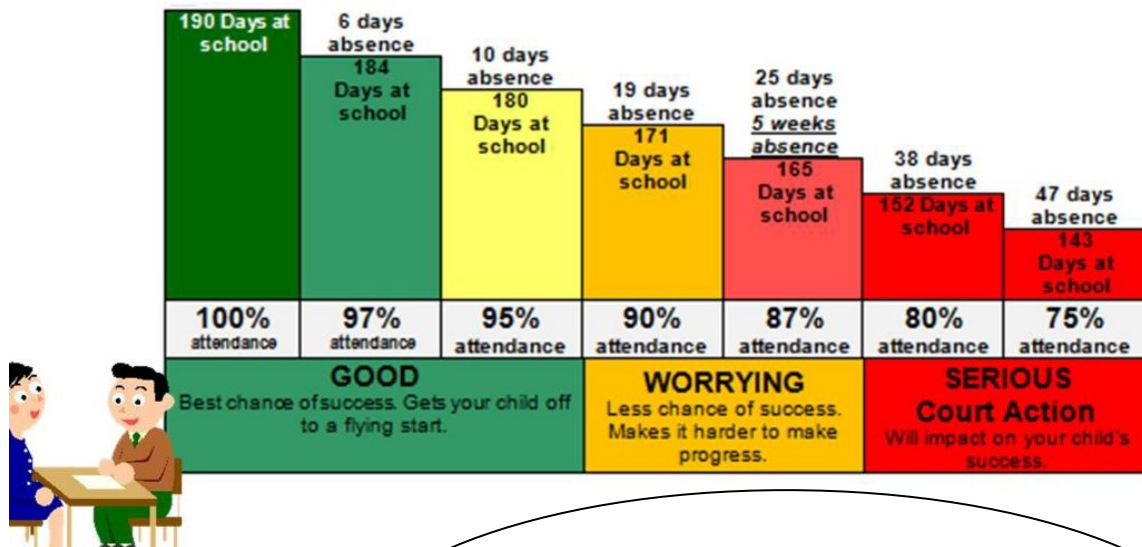
