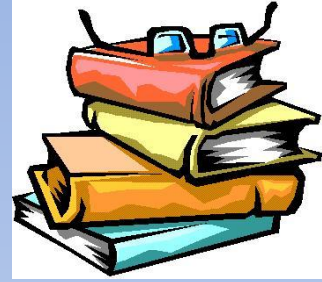


Numeracy

- Terms 1 and 2 – Place value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions, Geometry – position and direction.
- Terms 3 and 4 – Decimals, Percentages, Algebra, Measuring (converting units), Perimeter, area and volume, Ratio.
- Terms 5 and 6 – Properties of shape, Problem solving, Statistics.



Literacy



- In Literacy this year, the children are being taught through a text.
- The whole text is used.
- Read to the children, they read to each other, text marking, drama, writing in role, non fiction, poetry etc.
- Guided reading – every morning. Taught as a whole class.
- Reading records will be checked regularly.

Foundation subjects

- This term we are studying Landmarks, next term we are studying European Landmarks – Geography, History, Art and DT, will be taught through this topic.
- In term 3 and 4 we will have a History focus, which is Tudor and Victorian Exploration.
- In term 5 we are studying Geography and History, our topic will be Our Local Area.
- French is also taught weekly.
