

LO: To identify and use the present perfect tense

The present perfect is used when you talk about something you started in the past and are still do now.

We create the present perfect tense by using the words "have" or "has" with the past tense of a verb.

*I have played guitar for 5 years.*

*She has used the pencil case since the last holiday.*
