Dear Parents/Carers.

We are at the end of the penultimate full week of the term; a big thank you to those who are at home and continuing with their home learning—please do keep it up!

Children returning

Whilst we have guidance from the DfE regarding September, we have yet to receive detailed guidance from the local authority. Until I receive this, I will not be able to finalise my risk assessment for September. I do hope that the guidance is issued soon as I would like to share with you by the end of next week the plans for September.

On Wednesday 22nd July, we are offering your child the chance to meet their new teacher. We will be sending out further details early next week about this. Your child will either be invited to attend a morning bubble of 15 or an afternoon bubble of 15. They will stay on site for an hour and we hope most of this will be outside.

We return on 1st September, however we will be having two INSET days; therefore the children will be returning on Thursday 3rd September. There is an expectation that ALL children will be returning on this day. If you have any concerns about your child's return please do contact a member of the parent and pupil support team between 9 and 10 in the morning.

Making contact

During the 'lockdown' I have encouraged the use of my email address as a point of contact, which many of you, I hope, have found useful. Of late, I have seen an increase in emails being sent to me at weekends and late at night; I know I do not have to, but I do check my emails during this time and I then find it difficult not to respond. For my own well being this is not good. Therefore, I would politely ask that you only send emails to me during work hours and no later than 5p.m. and not at weekends. From September I will ask for a return to sending any enquiries to enquiries@craylands.kent.sch.uk which will then be forwarded on to me.

School reports are available for collection from today - Friday 10th July. A staff member will be out the front of the school today between 1 and 2 handing them out if you are able to come and collect. We will do the same on Monday 13th also. We will be sending them home with those children who are in school. You can collect at other times if you are unable to collect at these times. Once we have handed the reports out on these dedicated times, we will consider how best to send to those who are shielding and unable to collect themselves or send someone else to collect.
