Dear Parents/Carers,

We are now half way through this term and the children continue to work hard and behave well, remembering to follow the Covid Care Rules.

Covid Updates

A big thank you to you all for all that you are doing to keep Covid under control in our local community. As some of you will have seen in the news, Kent has been placed in tier 3 which means that amongst other things:

- You must not meet socially indoors or in most outdoor places with anybody you do not live with, or who is not in your support bubble, this includes in any private garden or at most outdoor venues.
- You must not socialise in a group of more than 6 in some other outdoor public spaces, including parks, beaches, countryside accessible to the public, a public garden, grounds of a heritage site or castle, or a sports facility - this is called the 'rule of 6'.

Could we remind you that if ANYONE in your household exhibits symptoms, the WHOLE HOUSEHOLD MUST self-isolate. Please DO NOT send your child into school if someone at home has had a test done until it has been returned as negative. Thank you.
