Dear Parents/Carers,

## Contact tracing

Schools are being asked to support with the track and trace process over the first few days of the Easter holidays. If your child either receives a positive test result up to Sunday morning (4th April) and/or they develop symptoms within the first 48 hours of the holiday but the test does not come back positive until a few days after, we will need you to let us know so that we can advise others in the child's bubble that they will need to self-isolate for 10 days.

## Covid precautions

Thank you so much for those of you who are following the guidance of keeping your child at home and getting a test when your child displays one of the main Covid symptoms. As some of the restrictions are easing outside of school, there is no change to those inside and on the school grounds so please could I ask that where possible, a face covering is worn on school site (even in the nice weather) and that you ensure you follow social distance guidance. We have been provided with new signage from the local authority which we will display ready for the new term.

## Poetry competition

During the first week of the whole school return, the children wrote poems reflecting on the period of remote learning. For KS2 this was part of a competition and we have sent off some entries as a school, after they were judged by staff members. The winning entries were from Freddie (Simon Class), Eliza (Dahl Class), Ami (Horowitz Class) and Hanisga (Morpurgo class). Congratulations to these children and let's wait and see if they are chosen as overall winners.

## After school clubs

We are hoping to be able to offer each class an after school club next term. These will be run by the class teacher and only attended by the children in the class bubble. We will be arranging days in the first week back and inform you further on how you can sign your child up to them.

At the end of the first week back, we will issue mini reports so you know how well your child has settled into school since they returned this term. This is in acknowledgement that the next parent/carer consultation session is at the end of the term.

It just leaves me to wish you all the happiest of Easter breaks and to thank you all once again, parents, children, staff and governors for all your support over the Spring term. Here's hoping that we are on the path towards normality. Take care and stay safe.
