Dear Parents/Carers,

A very typically British week weather wise...rain always follows the sunshine, however the coolness that it brings is welcome.

Gate closing time

A reminder that the gate in the morning now closes at 8.50a.m. There are still many people arriving between 8.50 and 8.55; some of the staff did not know about the change in time so perhaps this is why. All now know that 8.50am is when the gate closes so please do arrive in time.

Could we ask that where possible YR children are in school between 8.30 and 8.40 as some are arriving at 8.50; the class can not really start sessions until all the children are in. Many thanks in advance.

On Monday, the children have their class photographs. All of the children **MUST** wear their school uniform on this day please. To make it easier, **NO** year group will have PE on Monday. However, EYFS and Year 1 **MUST** bring their PE kit into school to change into for their sports day.

Sports day

On the next page are the timings for sports days next week. Due to the restrictions in place, we are only allowing 1 parent/carer to attend per child—siblings should only come along if there is no one else who can look after them.

The weather next week does not look promising; where possible, we will continue in light drizzle, amending the activities so the children are not running etc due to the risk of slipping on the wet grass. We will let you know as soon as possible on each day if we decide not to allow parents/carers to come due to the weather.

Next year

Some of you have asked when you will find out who your child's teacher will be next year; the answer currently is that it is still being decided. The process is not an easy one, especially as the school grows in size. We will be sending the information out to you all at the same time; this will be on Friday 9th July.

The children will have the opportunity to meet their new teachers twice this year; first on 12th July and then again on 19th July. This may need to be socially distanced and we will confirm details.

We are considering very carefully the impact that the mixing of any classes may have this year due to Covid. I am aware that EYFS parents/carers have been told to prepare for a mix—this is due to us not really knowing the children as well as we would have liked when the classes were originally created. In the past, we have mixed at the end of year 2 and we had considered a mix at the end of year 4. If we decide not to mix, it is down to the concerns we feel that a mix may have in light of the lockdowns this year as well as the confidence we have in the classes as they are and how settled they are. Any decisions will of course be communicated to you in advance but it is likely most classes will remain the same.

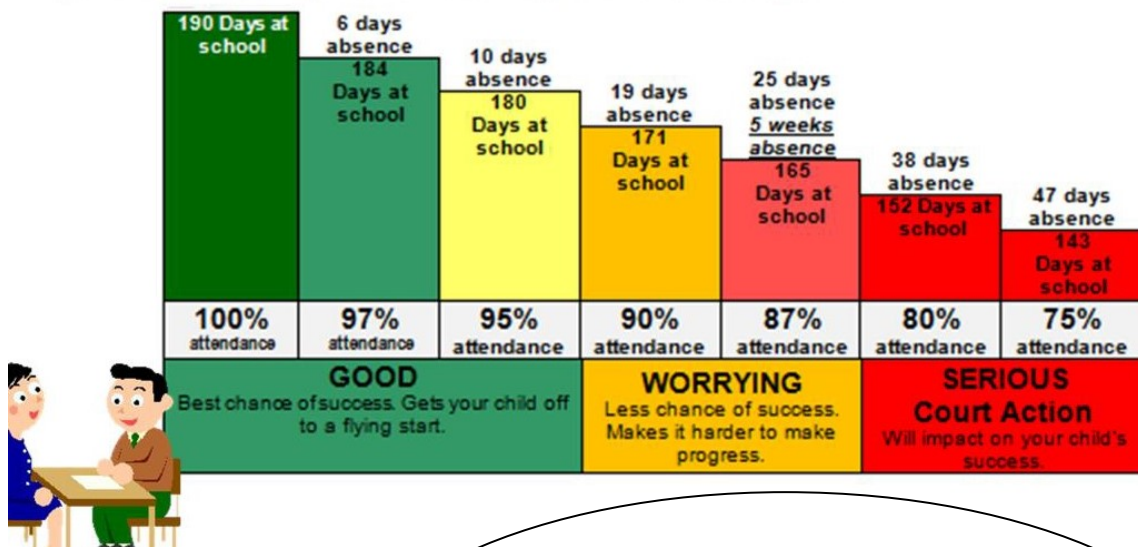
