A big thank you to those parents/carers who joined their children in the workshops held this week, the children considered what their friends do that make them happy, what others do that make them sad and what kind words they can say to others or have said to them to make them feel happier. It was great that those children in the workshop were able to relate the feelings to the zones of regulation that we are teaching across the school currently. We hope that those who joined the workshops found that it allowed you to start and hopefully continue this important topic of conversation with your child.

We have had some responses to the anti bullying survey sent out at the beginning of the week but far fewer than we normally do. Please could I ask that you find some time to complete them even if your child has not had any issues with bullying, as it is important to have this on record alongside anyone who has had issues.

In Number the children have focused on shapes in the environment and positional language.

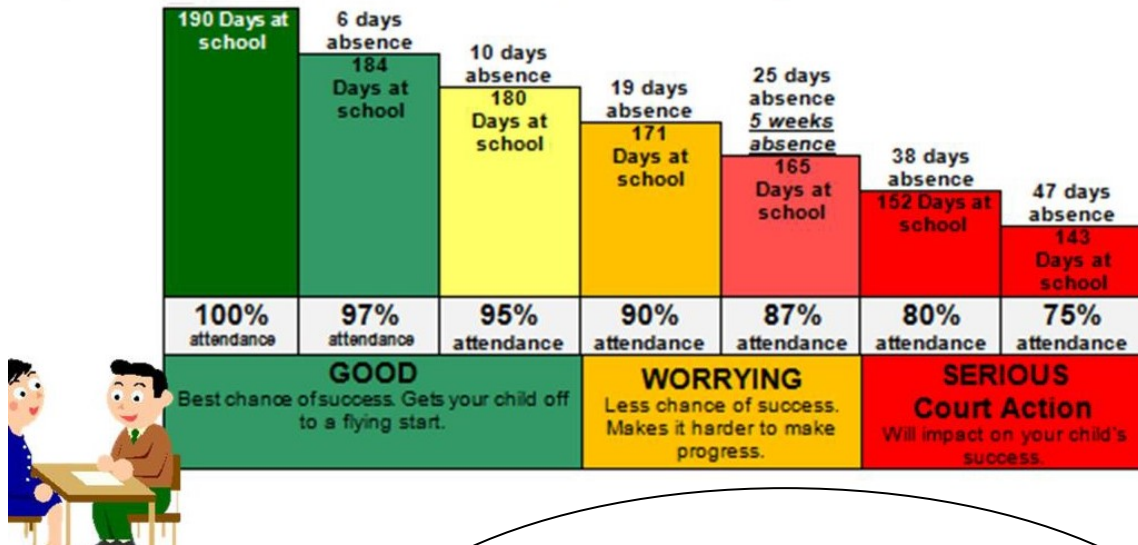
