<u>SATs</u>

The Year 6 SATs are over for another year and our children should be so proud of how they have approached the assessments this week. They truly have shown what Craylearners they are; never worrying, not giving up and have clearly shown how much they have listened in lessons using a range of strategies and techniques taught. We know they have worked so hard and we couldn't be more proud of them. Well done Year 6! The results of the SATs results will be shared in their end of year reports.

Year 2 will be taking their SATs assessments next week. Again, we know how hard they have been working and we are certain that they too will show that they are Craylearners. They are certainly nothing that they need to worry about. The results of these assessments will support the Year 2 teachers in making a teacher assessment for your child in their end of year reports.

After half term, Year 1 will have their phonics screening. They are very much used to going out with an adult and reading words that are presented to them and this is all that the screening entails. They will not even know that they are doing anything different.

Year 4 will be taking part in the multiplication check for the first time. Similar to times tables rockstars in a way, they are given a times table question and have 5 seconds to answer it. I believe they are given 25 questions in total to answer. The results of this will show how well our children know their times tables. I am unsure as to whether we will be provided with a score to share with parents/carers as this information has not been shared by the DfE yet.

In Numeracy they have been doubling numbers.




