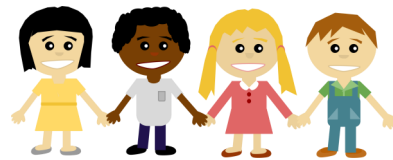

Finally, please remember to return Godstone trip forms after half term.

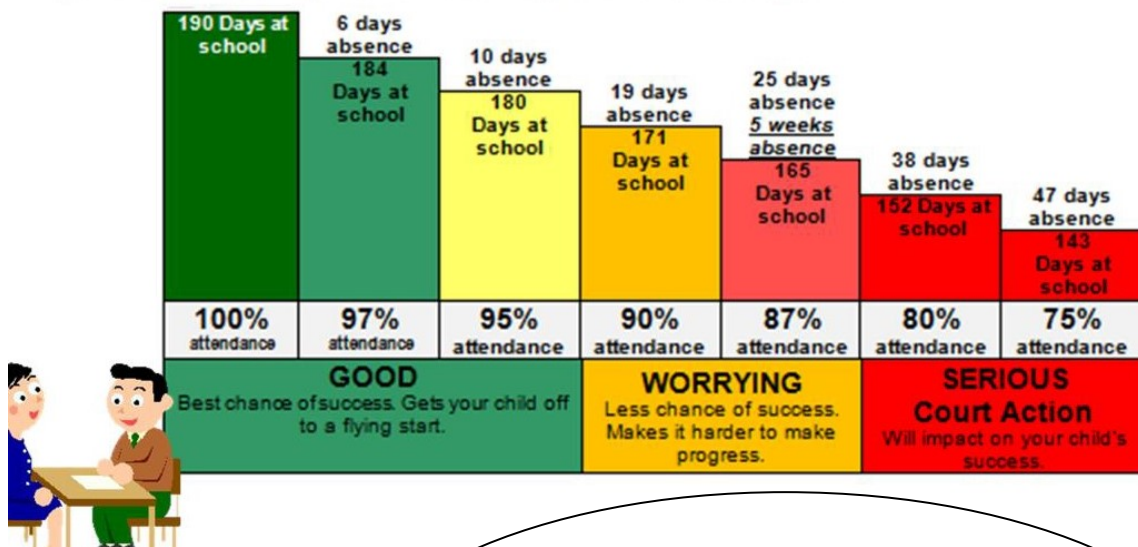
