We were also very lucky to have three police officers come and talk to the children on Wednesday. They got to sit inside a police van and put on hats - super fun.

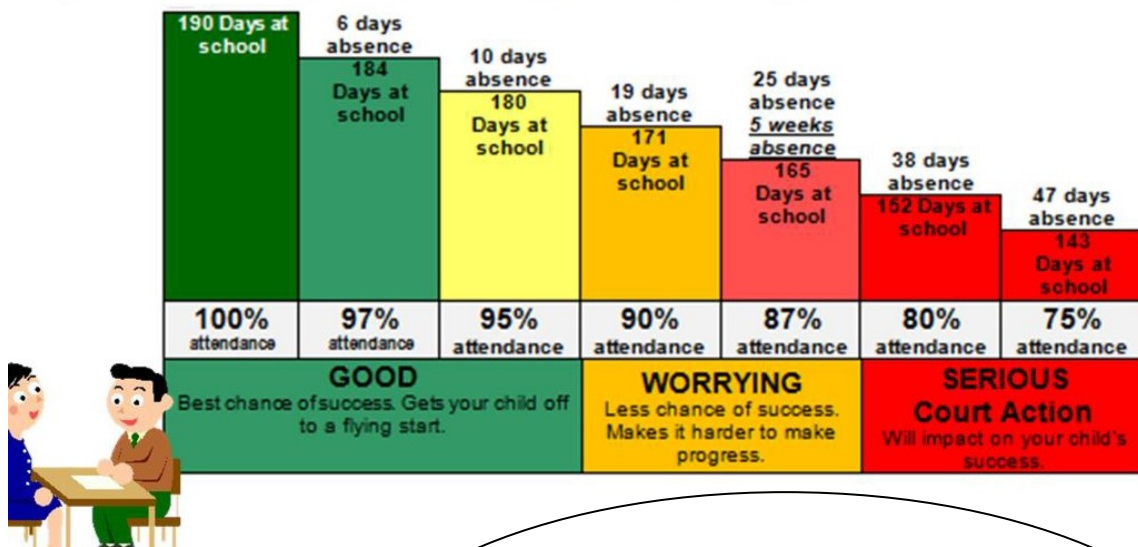
All of these experiences have fuelled the children's writing. In Maths, the children are focusing on spatial awareness; making and following maps. and plans.
