Reading mornings

Thank you to all those of you who have attended a reading morning with your children this week; we hope that you enjoyed this dedicated time to read with your child. Reading is such an important part of your child's education and it is vital that they read regularly; whether this be their school reading book, comics, non-fiction books—whatever they are interested in, we should encourage them to read.

Reading opens up our children's world even more—they gain knowledge from reading, widen their vocabulary and they have fun! Those who read more, become better writers as they have a better understanding of the grammatical structures and how to write for an audience. Those who read more, are more likely to be able to understand word problems in maths lessons, demonstrating their reasoning and problem solving skills. Those who read more can take part more confidently in our STAR topics, showing that they understand the historical, geographical or scientific subjects being learnt.

As part of your child's weekly home learning, we ask that they read regularly—preferably every day. We understand that this may not be possible for all and we would just encourage you to read at any opportunity.

Literacy - Phonemes g o c k have been taught and the corresponding letter formation sheets are coming home for practice.




Achievements outside of school...
