Dear Parents/Carers.

What a wet and windy start to the term—please do ensure your child wears a named coat to school....they do seem to get lost very easily.

## Drop Off Zone

I am sorry to sound like a broken record with regards to this, however I just wanted to remind you that we have closed the drop off zone currently due to a number of altercations and issues that occurred last week, along with the persistent use of the bays which I have asked on numerous occasions for you NOT to use.

I am aware that by not opening the drop off zone, it may cause more congestion on the roads and I do not intend to keep it closed for long, however I need to devise a new method of it's use. This is likely going to result in a single lane use, with cones in the bays to prevent people from parking up. It will ultimately result in a slower process moving through the zone, however it should prevent issues that occur from people trying to overtake each other and reversing out of spaces to get out.

However, I will warn you that if the new system does not work, I will seriously consider closing it permanently. The safety of our community is paramount and whilst I would like to say it is a small minority, the number of cars who parked in the bays yesterday morning was far too many, despite my School Comms request not to.

I will provide further updates next week regarding this.


