Craylearning value

This term, our Craylearning value is 'Asking questions'. We will be focusing on how important it is to ask questions, as they can help us to find out more information and learn more. We will look at open and closed questions and how we can use these in our learning. It is so important for children to be inquisitive in their learning. At the end of the term, up to 5 children in each class in years 1-6 will be invited to a special assembly if they have shown that they can use this Craylearning skill.

STAR topics

The children will be learning about the following in their STAR units of work over the Spring Term:

Year 1- What is it like where we live in the past?

Year 2- How did the Victorians change nursing?

Year 3 - What was life like in the Stone Age?

Year 4—Why did the Romans invade Britain?

Year 5—What is happening to the coasts of the UK?

Year 6- During which Queen's reign was the most progress made - Elizabeth 1 or Victoria?

We hope that the children enjoy these units of learning and complete some home learning based on them.


We are now teaching Phase 3 sounds; we have sent home the guide for these along with new reading books and home learning.


Alive in 5 is the title of the Maths unit we are on, exploring the concept of zero and securing quick recall of number bonds within 5.
