#### Forest School

Each term, a different year group has the opportunity to visit the school meadow and take part in forest school with our forest school lead Mrs Strudwick. They take part in a number of activities, working together and exploring this environment. A big thank you to Mrs Strudwick for running this in all weathers—especially of late as it has been cold, rainy and windy. Your child may come home a little muddy sometimes, but I can assure you that they thoroughly enjoy their time at forest school.

### Online Safety

In this week's assembly, we focussed on online safety and in particular discussing what cyberbullying is. We discussed how it can make people feel and discussed some different examples. We also looked at what children can do if they encounter cyberbullying including:

Report: report via the online site that you experience it on, then tell a trusted adult about it and ask for help.

Save: Keep evidence; take screenshots

Block: Block the person or group of people responsible

We will continue to discuss online safety in next week's assembly and we are planning on a workshop for parents/carers in term 4—further details will be sent out about this.


